



INSTRUCTIONS FBFC143 – Angelina and Reflectra Stitchfoil Christmas Trees

You have received two types of designs for the tree:

For Angelina	For Stitchfoil
Deesign-01a	Design-01F
Deesign-02a	Design-02F
Deesign-03a	Design-03F

You can also use the Angelina Version for regular fabric applique.

ANGELINA VERSION

You will find 3 color stops at the beginning of the design – Basting 1, Basting 2 and Tackdown. Then there are two regular colors – the first stitches the veins in the tree sections and the last stitches the final satin stitch outline. These last two can be the same color or different colors.

Prepare Angelina

I used both film and fibers, but you could use just one type. For the Large Green Tree, I just used fibers. I first put down some of the Enchanted Forest.



Then I laid some Christmas Green on top



I used the two colors because I wanted some variation in the tree. I then fused the fibers between two sheets of Teflon pressing cloth for 3 seconds.



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I didn't want so much of the brown to show so I put a few more green fibers on top and fused again.

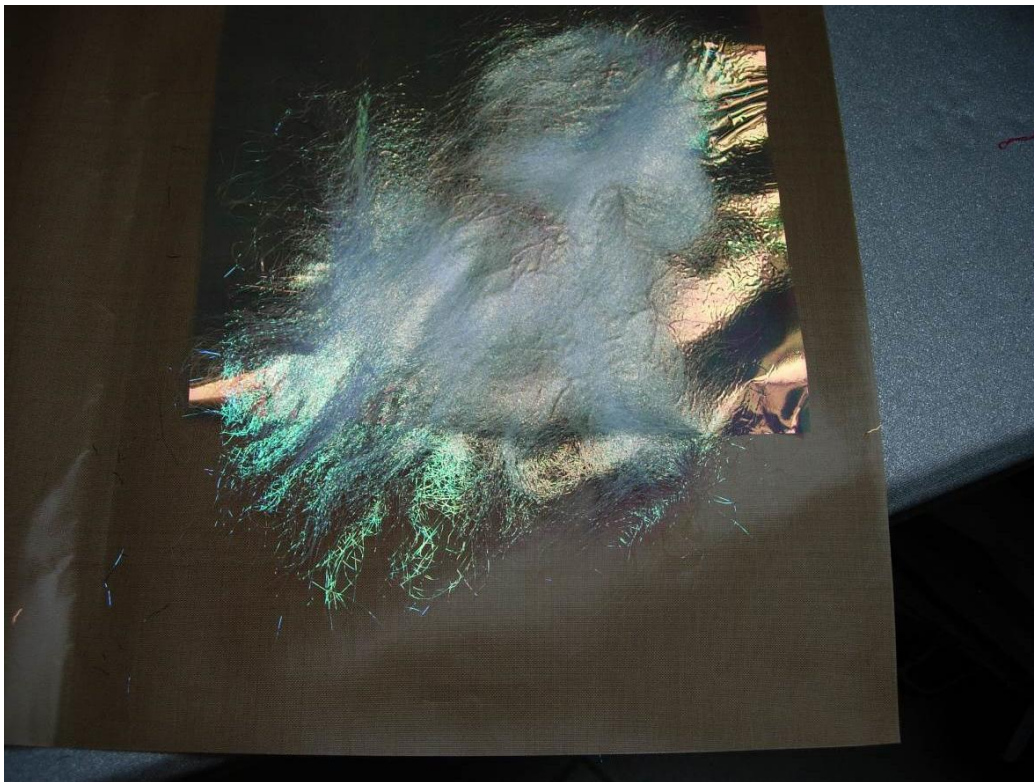


I then laid my fibers on top and fused all together.

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Do you notice how the white fibers look dull in the middle? This is because I left the iron down too long. I wanted to show you what can happen. But, I still used this for my tree and it came out very pretty.

For the Blue tree, I used film and fibers.



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REFLECTRA STICHFOIL VERSION

There is no preparation needed for the foil. Just cut a piece to fit your design plus a big enough margin to tear it away at the end and remove the paper backing.

TO STITCH the Design – ANGELINA VERSION

Stitch Color Stop 1



Lay your piece of prepared fibers on top and Stitch Basting 2.

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Remove hoop from machine and trim the excess Angelina. Return to hoop and stitch the remainder of the design.

For the White Tree I used both film and fibers. Since the Film wasn't wide enough, I first overlapped two pieces slightly.

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REFLECTRA STITCHFOIL VERSION

These designs have color stops Basting 1, Basting 2 and the Design color.

Stitch Basting 1 and lay a piece of Stitchfoil on top.

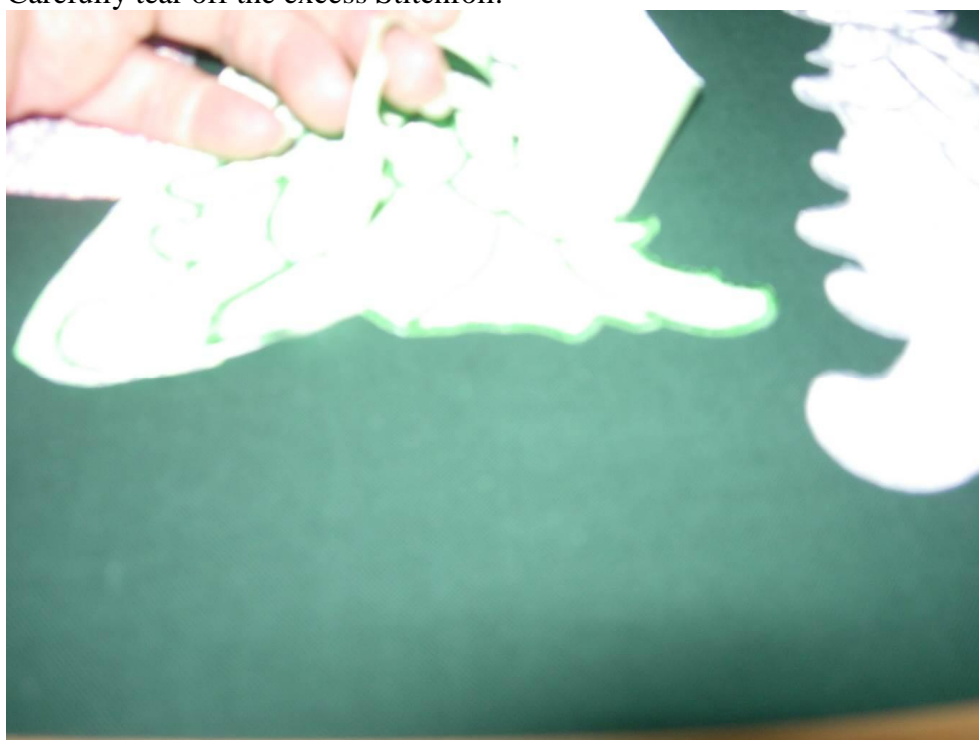


Stitch remainder of design.

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Carefully tear off the excess Stitchfoil.



Sorry for such a bad picture! Stitchfoil sometimes blinds the camera. LOL

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Have fun decorating your trees!

AN IDEA: for a quick Christmas Wall hanging, take a piece of white fabric and felt and a piece of dark blue for the sky. Dot different colors and types of your Christmas trees to make a little forest. Add some crystals.
